

What time is check in/check out?

You may check in anytime after 3pm. Check out is no later than 11am.
We ask that you respect these times, so all involved are happy.

Can my sweet dog join along?

Hmmm...Paw Paw likes to ask more questions to get to know your fur baby before agreeing. If Paw Paw is in agreement, we do require a pet agreement to be signed along with a refundable \$250 pet deposit.

How many guests does the cabin sleep comfortably?

We have a queen bed in one bedroom and a twin bed in the other room.

We can place a rollaway bed in the cabin for extra sleeping space.

We say the cabin can comfortably sleep 5 if you are willing to use the rollaway bed.

Do you provide linens and towels?

Yes! And if for some reason you need more than the amount provided, we can arrange to have some more delivered.

We do have beach towels for your use, as well.

Where is Glenburn, ME and what is nearby?

We are outside of Bangor (where you can find grocery stores, urgent cares, restaurants, etc.) and only 10 miles from Bangor International Airport. Orono is next door where you can find the University of Maine.

Pending on tourist traffic, you can drive to Bar Harbor and Acadia National Park in about an hour.

But, don't let all this convenience fool you. The cabin is nestled far enough away to give you the feel of pure peacefulness.

Is the cabin kid friendly?

We do sit mighty close to the lake. So, please be mindful of this.

However, we say if the cabin accommodates your needs please come and enjoy! Play responsibly!

Can we fish in Pushaw Lake?

Absolutely! The pier allows easy access for fishing. We have a pretty wide variety of fish in the lake.

Please note the following:

No resident or nonresident, 16 years of age or older, may fish in inland waters or transport fish taken from inland waters without first obtaining a valid Maine fishing license. Maine Residents may obtain fishing licenses from any resident license agent. Nonresidents may obtain fishing licenses in person or by mail from the IF&W Department Office in Augusta, or from any of the numerous nonresident license agents throughout the State. Can we rent the cabin during the winter months?

Unfortunately, our season begins in April and closes in November.

We are gradually working to make the cabin an all season cabin, but that will come in due time. Be on the lookout for this!

Why do you have a water cooler?

Our water is fed into the cabin from the lake by a water pump.

We do not expect you to drink this water unless you boil it before consuming.

It is ok to bathe, wash dishes, and general cleaning.

However, please feel free to use the water from the water cooler for your consumption.

What are your payment options?

We accept credit/debit cards via Square. We will send an invoice to your email to complete the transaction.

Do you have a cancellation policy?

While we understand that things come up, we ask that for a full refund to be issued you must provide written communication (via email pawpawscabinrental.com) 30 days before check in date.

If written cancellation notice is given 29-14 days before check in date, half of your reservation fee will be returned.

NO REFUND GIVEN FOR CANCELLATION 13 DAYS OR LESS PRIOR TO CHECK IN DATE.

Who picks up the garbage on garbage day?

If your stay happens to fall on a Tuesday, please do not be alarmed if you see our groundskeepers picking up the trash and taking it to the end of the road for garbage day on Wednesday.

Is there heating and cooling in the cabin?

The beautiful thing about Maine is that the temperatures remain fairly pleasant during the summer months. We do not have an air conditioner, but do have 2 standing fans that are available for your use.

There is a propane heater that is efficient in keeping the cabin warm during the cooler weather.
